Please make you arrive on time and that you are prompt at picking your child up on time. Lateness affects your child's attendance and their learning. If you are going to be late, please inform the office.

Please talk to your children a bout the different sounds they can hear, at home or when

you go out. Talk about what makes the sound and a bout what it sounds like. You could even try to make the same sound.

Helping your child at home Please encourage your children to dress themselves, including putting on their own shoes and coats. Encourage them to talk about the pictures they may draw. Please use our library to share a book with your child as much as possible.
