Your child will be assigned a key person. This person will spend time with your child, getting to know them and taking aobservations about how your child is learning. You will find who your child's key person is on the Nursery notice board. Your child will spend time with their key person at the start of each session.



Our first core story this half term is *The Gruffalo*. Please talk to your child about the forest and about the Gruffalo.



Our other core story this half term will be *Wow! Said the Owl.* Please talk to your children about the story. We will be naming colours and finding objects which have the same colour.





Please feel free to borrow a book from our library which is situated in the cloak room. Please only take books from these boxes. We encourage your child to change their book as much as they would like. Children really enjoy books and stories. Sharing books at home is a

good way to encourage children to become good readers. Please talk to your children about the books they bring home. Book bags can be bought from the school office.

In Nursery we offer the children the opportunity to play outside whenever possible. Most children enjoy outdoor play which provides a range of experiences not available inside.

As the weather gets colder please make sure your child brings a coat to Nursery. Please encourage your child to put their own coat on. It would help us if you could write your child's name in their coat. Children also need to wear black shoes or plain black trainers suitable for outdoor play.

The session ends at **11:30** am and **3:15** pm. Doors will open from **11:25** and **3:10** to enable to collect your child. If you are going to be late, please inform the office.

When entering Nursery, please allow your child to hang up their own coat, choose their own book and then go and sit in their key worker groups. Please feel free to speak to your child's key person if you have any worries or concerns. 15 minutes after the door closes, a tambourine will sound telling parents that it is time to leave.

Our topic for this term is *The Forest*. We will be learning lots of



things about the forest. We will talk about the forest including what it looks like and what animals will live in the Forest. We will read the Gruffalo story and talk about colours. In Maths, we will be looking at colours and trying to sort objects into colour groups. We will

also be listening for different sounds. Please talk to your children about the different sounds they can hear, at home or when you go out. Talk about what makes the sound and about what it sounds like. You could even try to make the same sound.

Helping your child at home

Please encourage your children to dress themselves, including putting on their own shoes and coats. Encourage them to talk about the pictures they may draw. Please use our library to share a book with your child as much as possible.
