The children have made a fantastic start with their Raving Readers. Please ensure that they are returned daily, along with other homework books in their bookbag so that we can work alongside you with this in school.



During our <u>English</u> lessons this term, we are learning about familiar settings and developing our reading. We will be focussing on reading common words fluently and using phonics to support the reading of unfamiliar words.

In <u>Maths</u> lessons we will be practising counting and learning to represent numbers in different ways. We will also be exploring addition using different strategies.

In <u>Science</u> lessons we are investigating the seasons and the changes they have on the area around us.

In <u>Geography</u> we are exploring "Growing up in Great Horton". This will include looking at our school on a map and learning about where we live. We will attend a trip to another area of Bradford where we can compare differences between the two locations.

During our <u>Art</u> lessons, we will be exploring colours and studying the work of Mondrian.

In **Computing** we will be learning how to log on and off, and navigating the computer.

We will be practising our gymnastic skills in our <u>**PE**</u> lessons, as well as developing our catching and throwing skills.

In <u>PSCHE</u> we will be exploring important issues in our society and new beginnings to help us settle in to the very busy, exciting year! We look forward to a great year ahead and to working with your wonderful children.


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Dear Parents/Carers,
