What we will be learning about this term in Maths and English:

Year 2 will be an exciting year where your child will be learning new skills and knowledge through a wide variety of activities both inside and outside the classroom.

In **mathematics** this half term, children will be developing their understanding of place value, learning strategies for calculating, solving mathematical problems, sorting 2D and 3D shapes and beginning to learn the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

In **English lessons** children are exploring stories with familiar story settings and developing ideas for writing their own stories. Children will then draft, edit and improve their story to create a final version.

## P.E.

Children have P.E. lessons twice each week:  
\* **2 Holly** on **Monday** and **Thursdays**  
\* **2 Elm** on **Tuesday** and **Friday**

P.E. kit should be brought to school in a separate P.E. bag. Children will need:  
- A white t-shirt  
- Black trousers or shorts  
- A black jumper  
- A pair of trainers

Please ensure all P.E. kit and school uniform is clearly labelled with your child's name and class.

This term our **Copthorne Curriculum** theme is 'Lady of the Lamp!' As **historians** we will be studying and comparing the lives of significant women in history such as; Florence Nightingale and Edith Cavell. As **geographers** we will be studying maps, looking at the journey Florence Nightingale made across the globe. As **artists** we will study and imitate the work of Andy Warhol to create Pop Art through the use of dots, lines and printing. As **scientists** we will be learning about animals and their habitats as well as what they need to survive in different environments. During **PE** we will master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing, and catching, as well as developing balance, agility, and co-ordination.

Throughout all our lessons we will be focusing on children developing their perseverance and collaboration learning muscles.

## Homework

- \* Spellings - Children will have weekly spelling tests each **Friday**. Spellings will be handed out on **Friday** so that children have time to learn their spellings ready for their test.
- \* Raving Readers- Children are expected to read for **10 minutes** each night with an adult. Please sign their Raving Reader Record next to the book title to ensure your child's reading is recorded on the reward chart. (If your child has not finished the book please record the page number. There are also activities in the back of the raving reader book for children to complete and awards to be won!
- \* Maths and English - homework will be given out weekly on **Friday** and should be returned to school the following **Monday**. Children should complete homework in homework books using a pencil and their best presentation unless their homework has been set online.
- \* School finishing times: lessons finish at **3pm**, so children will be brought to the cloakrooms as soon as possible after this time.
