What we will be learning about this term in Maths and English.



In <u>English</u> lessons this term, we will continue to use the story 'The Journey' as a stimulus for our learning. This half term we will focus on balanced arguments, we will look at the appropriate language and manner of presenting debates effec-

tively.

During Mathematics this term, we will be learning about fractions, percentages and decimals and how to apply them within context. We will also be revisiting the 4 op erations and applying them to fractions.

Reading

Please ensure that your children make the best progress in reading this year by encouraging them to read their Raving Readers book at home **every day** for a **minimum of 20 minutes** and then ask them questions about what they have just read using the new Raving Reader activity journal. We would also recommended them using Bug Club, which can be used as part of their raving readers as this websites asks appropriate questions about the text to deeper understanding.

In <u>Copthorne curriculum</u> we will be learning all about the
