Learning outdoors

In Nursery we offer the children the opportunity to play outside whenever possible. Most children enjoy outdoor play which provides a range of experiences not available inside.



As the weather turns colder please make sure your child brings a coat to Nursery. Please encourage your child to put their own coat on. It would help us if you could write your child's name in their coat. Children also need to wear black shoes or plain black trainers suitable for outdoor play.



Session times



Nursery begins promptly at **8:30am** for the morning session and promptly at **12:15pm** for the afternoon session. Please ensure your child arrives on time to Nursery. On arrival, please assist your child to find

their own name card and post it in the box. Then, you are welcome to settle your child into an activity before leaving. Doors will close no later than 8:45/12:30 to enable us to register the children and begin our group sessions. If you arrive after this time, please report to the school office who will assist you.

The session ends at II:30 am and 3:15 pm. Doors will open from II:20 and 3:05 to enable to collect your child. Please make you arrive on time and that you are prompt at picking your child up on time.


If you would like to donate snack money this half term, please give $\pounds I$ to your child's key person.

Our core story this half term is 'The Gruffalo'. We will be learning all about the characters, different places such as forests, woods, and linking this to building our own dens outside. The characters also talk about different food such as 'Owl ice-cream' so we will be cooking, baking and using the dough/mud kitchen to make some interesting recipes.





Our Maths core story will be 'Aliens love underpants' we will look at patterns and size. We will be commenting on different patterns and shapes we see in the environment. Talk to your children about the clothes they wear, the patterns in wallpaper, carpets, or any fabrics in shop windows.
