Areas of Learning



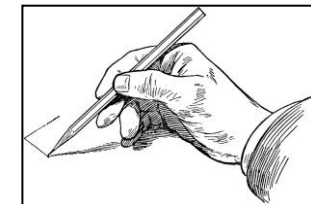
We will also use our Computing to research different portrait artists.
