KS2 SATs Week 9th May – 12th May

Dear Parents and Carers,

As many of you will be aware, our Year 6 children will be sitting their KS2 SATs tests next week from Monday to Thursday. These tests will be taking place in the Year 5 and 6 classrooms and the first set of tests will be starting early, at 8:30am each day. To make sure that the children taking the tests at this time receive the best possible start, we need to ensure that their tests are not disturbed by undue noise from the back playground as children arrive for school.

With this in mind, there are a few changes to dropping your children off next week.

Reception

Reception children will still enter from their normal collection point on the back playground

Year 1,2,3 & 4

- All children in years 1 to 5 will enter and leave school from the front playground
- Years 1 & 2 will be collected from the Year 2 door on the front playground
- Years 3 & 4 will be collected from the Year 4 door on the front playground

Year 5

Year 5 children will be working in the hall all week as their classrooms are being used to administer SATs. Their teachers will be collecting them from the **front playground** at the fire exit at the bottom of the library staircase every day except Friday. They will then go straight into the hall where their lessons will take place.

Year 6

Year 6 are invited to attend breakfast club and should come in through the main office. They should arrive no later than 8.00am.

We appreciate that this is a slight change to our normal start to the day but want to give our Year 6 children the best start to their tests as they have worked so hard all year in preparation.
